## Kids Can Sew! After School Club

### The Basics

We require at least **TWO** private lessons before we can allow new students to join the group. Why? So, they will be familiar with their own sewing machines, and also get to know the instructors.

### Other Requirements

Each student must have their own sewing machine in good working order, as well as some very basic supplies, such as scissors for cutting threads, pins, and a seam ripper.

### The Fee

We charge only \$25.00 per session. Private lessons are one hour each; group lessons are an hour and a half. All sessions include the majority of supplies, unless there is a project with more expensive elements that are required. In this case we will let you know, and it is rarely more than an additional \$10.00 for one session.

Our Kids Can Sew Club meets about twice a month during the school year, with students from 6 years old up into their teens. They make amazing projects each month, and we try to end the year with a project that will benefit the community. Class size is limited to 4 students.
