Kids Can Sew! After School Club

The Basics

We require at least TWO private lessons before we can allow new students to join the group. Why? So, they will be familiar with their own sewing machines and also get to know the instructors.

Other Requirements

Each student must have their own sewing machine in good working order, as well as some very basic supplies, such as scissors for cutting threads, pins, and a seam ripper.

The Fee

We charge only \$30.00 per session. Private lessons are one hour each; group lessons are an hour and a half. All sessions include the majority of supplies, unless there is a project with more expensive elements that are required. In this case we will let you know, and it is rarely more than an additional \$10.00 for one session.

Our Kids Can Sew Club meets about twice a month during the school year, with students from 6 years old up into their teens. They make amazing projects each month, and we try to end the year with a project that will benefit the community. Class size is limited to 4 students.

Class DESCRIPTIONS

These are the alphabetical descriptions for the classes that are listed by dates on Page 4. Class fees do not include supplies, unless stated otherwise in the descriptions. Be sure to ask for your Supply Lists when you sign up for your classes! Remember that we also give a 10% discount on any class supplies (just remind us when we're checking you out, please!). (If we have an abundance of interest in a class we will add a second class.)

<u>Football Goalpost Center Piece</u> – Just in time for football season this cute center piece features a football going through a goalpost. This will be made in 2 sessions.

<u>Insulated Bowl Cozy</u> – Make this cute bowl cozy for those hot bowls coming out of the microwave or crockpot dinners.

Machine Embroidery Club - Join us whether you have an embroidery machine or not! If you do, please bring it; if you don't, you can rent one of ours for only \$25 per session! (Why not get to know and love machine embroidery before you buy your new machine?) Choose a Morning or Afternoon session usually on the Third Friday of each month. Class is \$25 per session.

- <u>Sept 19th</u> -
- Oct 17th Halloween Gnome Sketch Embroidery Optical Illusion Pillow Sew simple, sew quick-this 3-yard quilt looks way fancier than the time it takes to make it. This is done in 2 sessions.

<u>3Yard Porch Rail Quilt</u> – This simple 3-yard quilt is so easy to make but looks like it took hours to make. This is done in 3 sessions.

<u>Tetris I-Pad Cover</u> – Do you remember the game Tetris? Need a I-Pad /Tablet Cover? Then this class is for you. Adding a twist to the cover it is done in the pattern of a Tetris game. This is a 2-session class.

<u>UFO Class</u> – Do you have any projects that you haven't finished and need a little help to finish then this class is for you. Bring your project and we will help you finish it.

NEWS BRIEFS

We now have a \$20 Non-Refundable Diagnostic Fee which can be applied to your repair bill as long as we are able to fix your machine. If we can't fix your machine, then the fee is for our labor in evaluating it. Many times, we can tell you before you leave your machine if we think we can repair it or not. The fee is due when you drop off your machine (applies to both sewing machines & vacuum cleaners).

Effective February 1st, 2025, our private lessons will be \$30 per hour. Group classes will be as listed on the class schedule.
