As the summer approaches, now is a good time to plan for one of our Summer Sew Camps!

For our “newbies” we require that each child must take at least TWO one-hour private lessons (they CAN both be on the same day, back-to-back) before we can allow her/him to join any of our groups. You can schedule these appointments any time that works both for you and one of our instructors (see below). Each one-hour private session is only \$25, and this fee includes their supplies. We try not to have any unexpected fees popping up on you. We understand; we have kids, too!

One other requirement before your child can join any group is that they **MUST** have their own sewing machine in good working order with both a straight stitch and a zig-zag stitch (**HINT: Perfect Birthday Gift!!**). If you have a machine but haven’t used it in a while, now would also be a really good time to have it serviced. We also have new machines available, starting at only \$169.95. The fee for regular Summer Camp is \$135 and includes all supplies whenever possible.

Regular Camp, Session I: July 23-26, 10 am-12:30 pm.

Regular Camp, Session II: July 30-Aug. 2, 10 am-12:30 pm. (this camp is FULL)

Regular Camp, Session III: Aug. 6-9, 10 am-12:30 pm.

Class DESCRIPTIONS

These are the alphabetical descriptions for the classes that are listed by dates on Page 4. Class fees do not include supplies, unless stated otherwise in the descriptions. Be sure to ask for your Supply Lists when you sign up for your classes! Remember that we also give a 10% discount on any class supplies (just remind us when we're checking you out, please!).

Caddy Pad – This is a cute portable ironing pad that folds up into a carrying case to take your iron with you to class. We will make it over two sessions.

Folded Hexagon Table Runner – Learn how to make this simple table runner that looks like it took you for forever. Made over two sessions.

Folded Star Center Piece – This beautiful center piece is done with 4" squares folded to make a beautiful star design. We will make this over 3 sessions.

French Bread Table Runner – This runner is a perfect scrap buster and is quick to put together plus lengthening is extremely simple. This is a two-session class.

Machine Embroidery Club - Join us whether you have an embroidery machine or not! If you do, please bring it; if you don't, you can rent one of ours for only \$20 per session! (Why not get to know and love machine embroidery before you buy your new machine?) Choose a Morning or Afternoon session usually on the Third Friday of each month. Class is \$20 per session.

- **April 19** -Shine Your Light Mug Rug Make this cute mug rug all in the hoop.
- **May 17** – Whimsical Watermelon Mug Rug This appliqued mug rug is done all in the hoop.

Memorial Bear – Do you have some shirts from a loved one or some baby shirts from a grandkid and don't know what to do with them? Make a bear out of them for a keepsake. This is a 2-session class.

Origami Sling Bag – Ever seen origami paper animals? Well, this uses some of the folding techniques to make a bag.

Sewing an Invisible Zipper – This class will teach you some tricks for putting an invisible zipper in pillows and garments.



NEWS BRIEFS

We now have a **\$20 Non-Refundable Diagnostic Fee** which can be applied to your repair bill as long as we are able to fix your machine. If we can't fix your machine, then the fee is for our labor in evaluating it. Many times, we can tell you before you leave your machine if we think we can repair it or not. The fee is due when you drop off your machine (applies to both sewing machines & vacuum cleaners).

What is in a Basic Sewing Kit?

A Basic Sewing Kit should include good scissors for cutting fabric, small scissors for cutting threads, pins, pin cushion, seam ripper, and some spare bobbins.
